the union which represents 22,000 CUNY staff and faculty, joined students during the rally, according to reports in The Baruch Ticker. The union has "denounced" the cuts in a statement released on their web-site.

"CUNY cannot absorb any more cuts," said PSC President Barbara Bowen in the statement. "The University

is already cramming students into overcrowded classrooms and squeezing 60 adjunct faculty into a single office. Enrollment is the highest it has ever been; the demand for a CUNY education has never been greater. It makes no sense—economically or morally—to cut the University now."
